This petition has come up before this court today in the presence of Mr. Vijaya Piruthivirajan, B.A., B.L., learned counsel for the petitioner/Accused and Mr. I. Farook Shah, B.A., L.L.M., Assistant Public Prosecutor, Gr-II for the State and upon hearing the arguments on the both sides and perusing the material records this court delivered the following,

ORDER

1. The petition has been filed by the petitioner U/S.480 BNSS for seeking bail. The petitioner was alleged to have been committed an offence under Section U/s.294(b), 323, 324, 326, 506(ii) IPC r/w 4 TNPHW Act.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the have been arrested by the respondent police and remanded to judicial custody on 05.03.2026 for the alleged offence U/s.294(b), 323, 324, 326, 506(ii) IPC r/w 4 TNPHW Act. The petitioner is innocent of the alleged offences. He will be released on bail, he undertakes to appear promptly. The alleged offences are non-bailable. The petitioner is willing to submit sufficient sureties. Hence, this Petition is filed.

3. The prosecution filed reply stated that the investigation is pending. Accused was produced through P.T. Warrant. If the accused released on bail, he will not present in trial proceedings. Therefore, raised objection for this application.

4. Heard. On perusal of the records, this case numbered as C.C.No.92/2023,

dt: 28.03.2023 on the file of judicial Magistrate Court, Tirukoilur and now transferred to this Court and new number assigned in C.C.No.107/2024 and on 27.12.2023 posted to summon to accused on 05.03.2024. On 05.03.2024. 02.05.2024. 11.06.2024, 02.07.2024, 05.08.2024, 03.09.2024, 08.10.2024, 03.12.2024, 28.01.2025. 04.03.2025, 22.03.2025, 14.05.2025, 28.07.2025 posted to summon to accused. Further On 25.08.2025 Court Notice to accused 1 to 4 with RPAD by 27.10.2025. On 27.10.2025 Court notice sent, AD card received in respect of A2, but not present , hence issue NBW as against A2 on 24.11.2025. On 07.02.2026 NBW pending as against A2. Subsequently on 05.03.2026 the accused – 2 Produced on P.T. Warrant remanded to Judicial Custody, to considering the same, so many hearings accused is absent, may be consider the same, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail with the following conditions:

1. The Petitioner/Accused shall execute two sureties a sum of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand only) to like sum satisfaction of this Court.
2. The sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond with copy of their Aadhar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.
3. The Petitioner/Accused shall appear before this Court daily at 10.00 a.m. until further Orders.
4. The Petitioner/Accused shall co-operate the trial proceedings and not tamper evidence.
5. **In the result**, this Petition is allowed with the above conditions.
