the parties, being the subject matter of this cause, in the presence of the parties and their counsel, and after a full and frank discussion of all issues factual and legal arising from the cause, the parties having agreed before us that there shall be an award/order/decreed in terms of settlement hereto made and the parties and their counsel herein having, in acceptance of the same, signed this in our presence, it is decreed / ordered.

“Both the parties are present .On negotiation , both parties have agreed for settlement of the dispute for a sum of **Rs. 30,000/-(Rupees Thirty Thousand Only)**

The 3rd respondent is directed to deposit the settled amount before the SDJ within 6 weeks from the date of this award , failing which the respondent agreed to pay interest 7.5% per annum on the award from today till the date of deposit.

The dispute between the parties is settled accordingly. Therefore , the award is passed in accordance with the sections 21/22E of Legal Services Authorities Act 1987.

As and when the award amount is deposited in the court, the same shall be disbursed to the petitioner/s through NEFT/RTGS,as per the directions of the High Court of Madras,in CMA No.428/2016, in the bank account of the petitioner/s as given below:
