This petition coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Thiru.G.Neerkathalingam, Advocate for the petitioner and Thiru.S.Thirumalaiappan, Public Prosecutor for the respondent and upon hearing the argument of both sides, this court made the following.

**ORDER**

It is an application for bail u/s.483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS).

FIR was registered against the petitioner/A1 for the offences u/s. 296(b), 126(2), 118(1), 103(1) of BNS. The occurrence happened on 22-12-2025 and the petitioner is under custody for the past 72 days from 23-12-2025 onwards.

As per FIR, The defacto complainant was living with her father and younger brother and her mother was left from her father from her childhood and that on 22-12-2025 at about 6-15 pm when the defacto complainant completing her tailoring work was standing near the PRC shed for getting bus, at that time A1 who is the brother of her mother came there and harass her and further the defacto complainant informed about the activity of A1 to her father, and the defacto complainant, her father and brother went to A1's house and for questioning about the harassment of defacto complainant, at that time A2 and A3 catch hold her father, A1 assaulted with iron rod and thereby caused injuries to him and A1 had also assaulted the defacto complainant. Due to the assault of the accused, the father of defacto complainant was died.

According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any such offence and prays to enlarge the petitioner on bail. On the other hand,

the learned Public Prosecutor contended that if the petitioner is released on bail he would tamper with the prosecution witness and hence he objected to grant bail to the petitioner.

Heard both sides. Records perused. On perusal of records would show that it is a case of murder and the petitioner is A1 and he is under custody for the past 72 days and the investigation completed, but charge sheet not filed for want of lab report and also the co-accused A2 and A3 were already released on bail by the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court. Considering the period of custody of the petitioner and also the co-accused were already released on bail, hence, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners with the following conditions.

Accordingly the petition is allowed and the petitioner/A1 is ordered to be released on bail on the following terms:-

i) The petitioner shall execute a personal bond for Rs.25,000/- with two sureties for the likesum each to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate No.II, Srivilliputtur.

ii) The petitioner /accused shall appear before the respondent PS, everyday at 6-00 pm until further orders.

iii) The petitioner shall not abscond either during the investigation or trial, that the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

iv) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the Judicial Magistrate is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Judicial Magistrate himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala (2005) AIR SCW 5560.
