This petition coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Thiru.M.Jeyakumar, Advocate for the petitioners and Thiru.S.Thirumalaiappan, Public Prosecutor for the respondent and upon hearing the argument of both sides, this court made the following.

ORDER

This petition has been filed u/s 483 BNSS seeking bail in favour of petitioner/accused. Petitioner is under custody for 14 days from 04-03-2026.

It is a case of jumped out of bail. A case in S.C.No.366/2025 is pending against the petitioner before this Court. Since the petitioner had failed to appear before the court regularly, the petitioner/accused was issued NBW on 22.10.2024 and accordingly, he was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 04-03-2026 and hence, the petitioner has approached this court for bail u/s 483 of BNSS.

The learned advocate for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner is an innocent, very poor and law abiding citizens and the petitioner voluntarily surrendered before this Court on 04-03-2026 and he is under custody for the past 14 days. The learned counsel for the petitioner has further contended that the petitioner is having permanent residence in the address mentioned in the petition and he is ready to execute bond assuring

that he will not tamper the witnesses and will not abscond from the legal process in future and hence, bail may be granted to this accused on any condition.

The learned P.P has contended that the case in S.C.No.366/2025 is pending before this Court for trial and the the alleged crime arose in the year 2023 and that if the petitioner is released on bail it would affect the further progress of the case and hence the prosecution has raised objection to release the accused on bail.

Having considered the submissions of both sides, it appears that a case is pending against the petitioner in SC No.366/2025 on the file of this Court for trying the offence u/s 294(b), 450, 397, 506(ii) of IPC and Section 3(1) of TNPPDL Act. It is a case of jumped out of bail and this petitioner is under custody for the past 14 days. The petitioner was already granted bail, but he has violated the bail condition and absconded from appearing before the Court, the NBW was issued on 22-10-2024 and he was secured on execution of NBW and he is under custody for only 14 days. The offence against the petitioner is robbery and he is the native of Sivaganga and he has 5 previous cases. Considering the short period of custody and the petitioner is involved in the offence of robbery and the NBW was pending from 2024 onwards and that if the petitioner is released on bail, he would abscond and the earlier bail petition in Cr.M.P.689/2026 was dismissed only on 07-03-2026, there is no change in circumstance, hence, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, the petition is dismissed.
