This petition coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Thiru.G.Mariappan, Advocate for the petitioner and Thiru.S.Thirumalaiappan, Public Prosecutor for the respondent and upon hearing the argument of both sides, this court made the following.

ORDER

It is an application for bail u/s.483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS).

The defacto complainant filed an intervening petition in Cr.M.P.No.827/2026 prays to dismiss the bail petition filed by the petitioner.

FIR was registered against the petitioner/accused for the offence u/s.69, 318(4), 296(b), 351(3), 77 of BNS and Section 67 of IT Act. The occurrence happened from 25.06.2023 to 27.05.2025 and the petitioner is under custody for the past 5 days from 13-03-2026.

As per FIR, the defacto complainant is living in Vaigai Street, R.S.Nagar, Virudhunagar, she has a daughter named Iswarya from the days of her husband alive, the defacto complainant and accused family are having friendship and her husband died in the year 2019, in the year 2020 the defacto complainant was intended to study her daughter for medical and the defacto complainant sold her jewels and land and gave a sum of Rs.59,00,000/- to the petitioner. Further, in the year 2023 the petitioner came to the defacto complainant's house and stated that his wife got divorced from him and on false promise to marry the defacto complainant and had

inter-coursed with her on many times. After that she came to know that the petitioner is living with her 1st wife and the amount of Rs.59,00,000/- received from the defacto complainant was spent by him for construction of his house and further he returned only a sum of Rs.30,00,000/- and he cheated the balance amount of Rs.29,00,000/-. When the defacto complainant demanded the said money, he threatened to kill her and also abused her using filthy language.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is an innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and hence bail may be granted to the petitioner on any condition. On the other hand, the learned P.P raised objection to grant bail to the petitioner on the ground that if the petitioner is granted bail he would commit similar types of offences again and hence he objected to grant bail to the petitioner.

The Counsel for the intervener along with the intervener appeared before this Court and objected to grant bail to the petitioner.

Heard the petitioner, the learned P.P. and the intervener. Records perused. On perusal of the records would show that it is a case of cheating the money and also have inter-coursed with her on false promise to marry her and the defacto complainant present before this Court and filed the intervening petition. On perusal of FIR, the defacto complainant was cheated with Rs.29,00,000/- and all along this petitioner had cheating the defacto complainant in all ways and the investigation is at early stage. Considering that it is a case of cheating the defacto complainant in all the ways and the offence is grave in nature and he is under custody for the past 5 days the investigation is at early stage, hence, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, the petition is dismissed.

The intervening petition in Cr.M.P. 827/2026 is considered and closed.
