This petition coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of, Thiru.M.Emarajan, Advocate for the Petitioner/Appellant/Accused and Thiru.S.Thirumalaiappan, Public Prosecutor for the respondent and upon hearing the argument of both sides, this court made the following

ORDER

This petition is filed u/s 430(1) BNSS for suspension of execution of sentence of imprisonment pending the appeal and for bail.

Heard both side.

The learned counsel for the petitioner/appellant/ accused has contended that the petitioner has been convicted for an offence punishable u/s 138 of N.I Act and sentenced to undergo S.I for one year each and to pay the compensation amount Rs.6,00,000/- to the complainant u/s 357(3) Cr.P.C. within one month from 29-04-2026 i/d to undergo S.I for one

month as per the judgment dt. 29-04-2026 in STC No.1374/2025 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court, Srivilliputtur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that on the date of Judgment the petitioner was absent and hence NBW has been issued against him.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has also submitted that the petitioner has filed Criminal Appeal before this court, that the petitioner is having more chances to succeed in the appeal and hence, this petition may be allowed. The learned counsel for the petitioner has given undertaking that the petitioner is willing to deposit 20% of the compensation amount before the trial Court.

Considering the above facts, circumstances of the case and in particular that the petition has filed this Criminal appeal and the petitioner has stated that he is having more arguable points in the main appeal and also he gave undertaking that he is willing to deposit 20% of the compensation amount before the trial Court, this court is inclined to suspend the sentence pending appeal and ordered to be released on bail the petitioner/accused/appellant on bail u/s 430(1) BNSS.

In the result,

i) The petitioner on being deposited a sum of **Rs.1,20,000/- (Rupees one lakh and twenty thousands only) before the trial court** within 30 weeks, the sentence awarded to the petitioner will be suspended till the disposal of the appeal and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail.

ii) The petitioner shall execute a personal bond for Rs.10,000/- with two ssureties for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court, Srivilliputtur.

iii) The petitioner shall appear before this Court for hearing on 03-07-2026 and on further hearing dates in C.A.184/2026.
