This Petition came up before this Court today i.e., 22.01.2026. Advocates M/s. E.Daniel Parnaba & S. Ponganagasureka, for the Petitioner/Accused. Advocates M/s. G.Dhinesh Kumar & G. Suseela, for the Respondent/Complainant. Upon perusing the case records, this Court delivers the following:

COMMON ORDER

1. The Petitioner had filed the above Petition in M.P. No. 20 of 2026, seeking an order to Re-Open the case.

The Petitioner had filed the above Petition in M.P. No. 21 of 2026 under Section 256 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, seeking an order to issue summons to

the Manager Karur Vysya Bank, Srivilliputhur Branch.

2. The Petitioner/Accused had stated that the Respondent filed the above Complaint and the Case is in the stage of defence evidence. The Karur Vysya Bank, Srivilliputhur Branch Manager has to be examined and to be summoned to produce important documents, as to issuance of Cheque Book and encashment of Cheques preceding and succeeding the Case Cheque Number. Examination of Karur Vysya Bank, Manager, Srivilliputhur is necessary, failing which, the Petitioner's case could not be put forth. Hence the above Petitions.

3. The Respondent counsel had endorsed in the Docket as, "Petitions may be allowed on cost".

4. The Point for consideration, is whether the above Petition has to be allowed or not?

5. Considering the reason stated by the Petitioner/Accused and the endorsement made by the Respondent Counsel as it is stated that the Branch Manager, Karur Vysya Bank, Srivilliputhur has to be summoned, for producing Records Available with him and it is stated that the Case Cheque is said to be drawn by the Accused from that Bank, this Court is of the Considered view that the Petitioner/Accused could be given opportunity to putforth his Defence, hence in the interest of justice and in order to ensure Fair Trial, this Court is of the considered view that the above Petitions, could be allowed on Terms.

In the result, the above Petition in M.P. No. 20 of 2026 is allowed on Condition

that the Petitioner pays a sum of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) to the Respondent on or before 02.02.2026, call on 03.02.2026.

In the result, the above Petition in M.P. No. 21 of 2026 is allowed on Condition that the Petitioner pays a sum of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) to the Respondent on or before 02.02.2026, call on 03.02.2026.
