Fresh case has been received by way of e-filing after being returned under Order VII Rule 10 CPC. Hard copy also filed. Let the same be checked and registered.

Non-Starter Report as per Section 12A of Commercial Courts Act 2015, (as amended by Act-2018) is already **on record**.

Issue summons for settlement of issues against the defendants on filing of the process fee by the plaintiff.

In addition thereto, process be also sent through registered/speed post AD. As prayed, the sealed covers containing the summons and complete paper book of the case be handed over dasti to the plaintiff/counsel for putting the same in the postal transmission. The original postal receipt(s) along with the downloaded track report from the website of India Post alongwith a certificate under Section 65B of Indian Evidence Act be placed on record by the Plaintiff/counsel on the next date. In case the Plaintiff has any e-mail, fax ID or mobile number (having WhatsApp/Gims/Sandes application) or any other electronic address of the defendant(s), the particulars of the same be filed/furnished in court by the Plaintiff vide an affidavit in accordance with Rule 12 of the Delhi Court Services of Process by courier, FAX and Electronic Mail Service (Civil Proceedings) Rule, 2010.

If such an affidavit, verifying the correctness of the electronic addresses of defendant(s), is furnished, the process be sent through electronic mode as well as through the Nazarat Branch enclosing

an electronic copy of the plaint and documents which be furnished by the Plaintiff.

In terms of Rule 13, Plaintiff is directed to place on record a copy of the plaint and documents in electronic format/scanned images in compliance of Rule 13 for forwarding/annexing/attaching the same with the process.

Requisite process fee for sending process by electronic mode in compliance of Rule 14 be also filed along with the copies as above for onward transmission to Nazarat Branch, Tis Hazari Courts, for service through electronic mode.

Process should also state that the Written Statement has to be filed within 30 days (extendable up to 120 days with the leave of the Court and subject to terms) from the date of service of process as per amended CPC (as applicable to Commercial Courts).

Steps be taken within 07 days from today.
