This Petition came up before this Court today i.e., 17.02.2026. Advocates M/s. S.Ananthakumar, R. Poovasagan, P. Dharmar & P. Muthukumar, for the Petitioner/Accused. Advocates M/s. T. Thirupathiraj & S. Venkatesh, for the Respondent/Complainant. Upon perusing the case records, this Court delivers the following:

**COMMON ORDER**

1. The Petitioner had filed the above Petition in M.P. No. 1 of 2026, seeking an order to Re-Open the case.

The Petitioner had filed the above Petition in M.P. No. 2 of 2026 under Section 145 (2) of Negotiable Instruments Act, seeking an order to recall PW1 and PW2 for

Cross Examination.

2. The Petitioner/Accused had stated that the Respondent/Complainant examined himself as PW1 on 29.08.2025 and PW2 was examined on 02.01.2026. During such time, Petitioner/Accused had not got some important documents, the said witnesses could not be cross examined by the Petitioner/Accused. The Petitioner/Accused has to be Permitted to Cross Examine PW1 and PW2, failing which the Petitioner will be put to irreparable hardship and inconvenience. For that Purpose, the case has to be re-opened. Hence the above Petitions.

3. Though Chance was given for filing Counter, the Respondent had not filed Counter. Hence, the Chance for filing Counter is Closed.

4. The Point for consideration, is whether the above Petitions have to be allowed or not?

5. Considering the reason stated by the Petitioner/Accused and considering that the Respondent had not denied the same by filing this Court is of the Considered view that in the interest of justice and in order to ensure Fair Trial, the above Petitions, could be allowed on terms.

In the result, the above Petition in M.P. No. 1 of 2026 is allowed, on condition, the Petitioner pays a sum of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) to the Respondent on or before 23.02.2026 Call on 24.02.2026.

In the result, the above Petition in M.P. No. 2 of 2026 is allowed, on condition,

the Petitioner pays a sum of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) to the Respondent on or before 23.02.2026 Call on 24.02.2026
