: JUDGMENT :
(Delivered on 20/02/2026)

1. The accused stands prosecuted for the offence punishable U/S. 281 of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023. The particulars of the offence read over and explained to the accused. The accused pleaded guilty for the same on 20/02/2026 by **Exh.2**. Today accused is present and pleaded guilty and prayed for mercy.

2. The only question therefore arised for me.

i)	Whether the accused person pleaded guilty voluntarily ?	Yes
ii)	Whether the leniency be shown to him ?	Yes

3. I answered these points in the affirmative for the reasons stated below.

: R E A S O N S :

4. The accused pleaded guilty to the plea at **Exh.2**. Considering the nature of offence, and plea of the accused, I think it is voluntarily made and hence I accept the plea of accused being done voluntarily. Accused submitted repenting upon the act the accused is only earning member of his family, his entire family is dependent on him, hence prayed for leniency while passing sentence. Thus considering fact that nobody is injured in the present offence and circumstances of the case, nature of offence, I have taken lenient view and proceed to pass the following order.

-. O R D E R :-

1. The accused is convicted under Section 229 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 for the offence punishable under Section 281 of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023 and shall pay fine of Rs.300/- **(Rs. Three Hundred Only.)** in default to undergo simple imprisonment for one day.
