ORDER

Disposal Type: Conviction

Records perused in CIS. Prima facie material available for the offence under Section 4A of TNP Act, and the same taken cognizance. The accused present along with his counsel. Advocate Mr.Arunraj filed a vakalat for the accused. Copies were furnished to the accused as per Section 230 BNSS. The substance of the accusation for an offence u/s 4-A TNP Act was explained to the accused as per Section 274 BNSS. The accused pleaded guilty and filed a petition for admission. Accordingly, I am satisfied that the admission is voluntary. Thus, this Court convicts the accused as per Section 275 BNSS and sentences the accused to pay a sum of Rs. 1,000/- towards fine u/s.4-A TNP Act. (Total fine Rs.1,000/-). In default of payment of the aforesaid fine amount, the accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 1 week.
