ORDER

The accused present along with his counsel and filed a petition to advance the hearing, and the same was allowed. Advocate Mr.Manivannan filed a vakalat for the accused. Copies were furnished to the accused as per Section 230 BNSS. The substance of the accusation for an offence u/s 4-A TNP Act was explained to the accused as per Section 274 BNSS. The accused pleaded guilty and filed a petition for admission. Accordingly, I am satisfied that the admission is voluntary. Thus, this Court convicts the accused as per Section 275 BNSS and sentences the accused to pay a sum of Rs. 1,000/- towards fine u/s.4-A TNP Act. (Total fine Rs.1,000/-). In default of payment of the aforesaid fine amount, the accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 1 week.
