By this order I am going to dispose of the petition bearing no. 183/15 under Order – VI, Rule - 17 read with Section 151 of C.P.C. filed by the plaintiff side.

Learned Counsel representing the defendant side has stated that he has no objection if the proposed amendments are allowed.
