The Criminal Miscellaneous petition came up before me on 27.03.2026 for hearing in the presence of Thiru.R.AjithKumar, Counsel for the petitioner and Thiru.P.Kannan, Additional Public Prosecutor not appeared for respondent and Reply of Soolakarai Police Station received, this Court delivered the following :

ORDER

1. The Petitioner/Accused was arrested on 10.07.2025 on execution of NBW for the offence punishable under Section 397, 452 of IPC in S.C.No.431/2025 on the

file of this court. Now the Petitioner/Accused filed a petition u/s.480 of BNSS seeks bail.

2. Heard both sides.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent has registered a case against the petitioner/accused for an alleged under section 397, 452 of IPC and the case was taken on file as S.C.No.431/2025 before the Hon'ble Principal District and Sessions Judge, Srivilliputtur and made over to this court. While the case is pending in the stage of opening the prosecution not appeared and NBW issued against him. Hence warrant was issued by Judicial Magistrate No.II court, Virudhunagar on 24.07.2024 and warrant was executed on 10.07.2025. The Petitioner/Accused is innocent and has not committed any offences as alleged. He is a law abiding citizen and so he will not abscond. The Petitioner/Accused is prepared to furnish substantial sureties to his due appearance. Therefore he humbly prayed that pleased to enlarge the Petitioner/Accused on bail. Hence, he has prayed for bail.

4. On the other hand, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor not appeared. Respondent/Police given a Reply stated that NBW was issued on 24.07.2024. The petitioner was arrested on 10.07.2025 after much effort. The case is pending for opening prosecution. If he is released on bail, he may abscond and the case could not be proceeded. Hence, he objects to grant of bail.

5. On perusal of the case records, it would go to show that NBW was issued against the petitioner on 24.07.2024 and the petitioner was arrested on 10.07.2025. The petitioner is in custody for 266 days. Considering the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner and also on the basis of undertaken made by Accused, this court is inclined to grant bail to him with condition.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a likesum to the satisfaction of this court and on further condition that

(a) the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb impression in the surety bond and submit a copy of their Aadhar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

(b) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness during trial.

(c) the petitioner shall not abscond during trial.

(d) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the prosecution is entitled to take appropriate action against the above petitioner in accordance with law as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K. Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]**.
