However, plaintiff remained absent and failed to take steps since long time. Therefore, after giving ample opportunities the suit was kept for dismissal order by passing order below **Exh.01** on 18.02.2026, 11.03.2026, 08.04.2026, 05.05.2026, 18.06.2026, 18.07.2026 Since then also plaintiff remained absent before the Court and failed to take steps. Today the plaintiff and his learned advocate called repeatedly till 5:30 pm. Both are not present before the Court. The matter is more than **10 years** old and alive on record without any effective steps by the plaintiff. The conduct of plaintiff shows that, he has lost his interest in the present suit. In my view present suit is fit case to dismiss in default. In the end following order:
