This date is fixed for reconciliation in connection with an application under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, filed by the petitioners-spouses. Heard both sides on the point of reconciliation. Despite efforts made, the reconciliation process fails. Accordingly, the matrimonial suit arising out of the application under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, is taken up for hearing.

Petitioner No.1, Sri Pintu Nandi and the petitioner No.2, Smt. Tanusree Mondal Nee Nandi have filed their evidence by way of Affidavit. Both petitioners are examined on oath and their evidence have been accepted as evidence of PW1 and PW2 respectively. PW1 filed his original Aadhaar Card bearing No.3278 2066 5233 along with its photocopy (original is returned after verification) (**Exhibit-1**) and he also filed their Marriage Registration Certificate issued by the appropriate authority (**Exhibit-2**). PW2 filed her original Aadhaar Card bearing no. 3530 5304 6043 along with its photocopy (original is returned after verification) (**Exhibit-3**).

Heard both sides. It appears from the evidence of P.W.-1 and P.W.-2 that their marriage was solemnized on 12.08.2021 (registered on 25.08.2021), according to the Hindu rites and custom. After marriage, they resided together as husband and wife. It appears further that they have been living separately since 05.06.2022, owing to difference of opinion and as they are not in a position to live together again, and have been living separately for more than one year and they have filed this suit for mutual divorce for betterment of their future life. Parties have agreed mutually to get their marriage dissolved by a decree of divorce on mutual consent

and their agreement is voluntary and without any condition, coercion etc. that would vitiate the consent in the eyes of law. Since the petitioners-spouses have filed this matrimonial suit under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, for dissolution of their marital tie for betterment of their future life and they are living separately for more than one year and also there appears not even bleak chance to restore their marital life, this Court finds no impediment but to accept their prayer for a decree of divorce under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

-: O R D E R E D :-

That the instant Matrimonial Suit under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, being Matrimonial Suit No.1705 of 2023 be and the same is decreed by mutual consent of the parties. The marriage between Sri Pintu Nandi and Smt. Tanusree Mondal Nee Nandi, which was solemnized on 12.08.2021 (registered on 25.08.2021), according to the Hindu rites and custom, and the marital relationship between them stands dissolved with effect from this date. Parties do get a decree accordingly.

Let a copy of this order along with a photocopy of the marriage certificate being No.WB33700400010500002272-2021-128061 dated 25.08.2021 (**Exhibit-2**), as submitted by the petitioners-spouses, be sent to the Marriage Officer Chhaya Ghosh having office at Ramkrishna Pally, Taki Road, Barasat, 24 Parganas(N), West Bengal, India, PIN 700124, for cancellation of the said certificate and for recording the fact of dissolution of the marriage of the petitioners-spouses in the concerned register(s).
