:: J U D G M E N T ::

Accused present copies furnished to the accused and he is examined U/Sec.251 Cr.P.C. for the offence U/Sec.185 of MV Act. Against Accused for which he admitted the offence voluntarily. The admission of the accused is voluntary one and out of their own volition. Hence the accused is convicted U/Sec.252 Cr.P.C. Hear the accused about the quantum of sentence and they prayed the court to take lenient view considering it as first instance. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the accused. is convicted U/Sec. 252 Cr.P.C and sentenced to pay a fine and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1000/- in default, each shall undergo (10) days S.I. for the offence punishable U/Sec.185 of MV Act.
