Order	Bail application is allowed.

ORDER

1. This is the second bail application filed on behalf of the accused who is alleged to have committed offences u/s 380 and 457 of IPC.
2. The case against the petitioner is that he committed house trespass and theft of one hand bag containing Rs.8000/-, one Panchaloha idol of Lord Ganapati worth Rs.700/-, ATM cards and Aadhar card of the complainant, which was kept on the dining table inside the hall of complainant's house, that is, TC 02/2300, Sree Ganesh House at Pattom at about 5.00 a.m. on 21.01.2024 and thereby committed the offences as alleged against him.

3. The accused was arrested and produced before this court on 25/01/2024 and was remanded to judicial custody.

4. Heard both the sides.

5. The only point that arises for consideration is whether the petition is to be allowed.

6. The point : I have perused the records. Accused is under custody from 25/01/2024.

Final report is filed. Further detention of accused in custody is not necessary. Hence, the accused / petitioner is granted bail subject to the following conditions.

7. In the result, the CMP is allowed and the bail is granted as follows:

1. The accused shall execute bond for Rs.25,000/- with two solvent sureties each for the like sum. One of the surety shall be a close relative.
2. He shall not involve in any similar offences while on bail.
3. Any violation of any of the above conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

Communicate the order through Jail Superintendent concerned.
