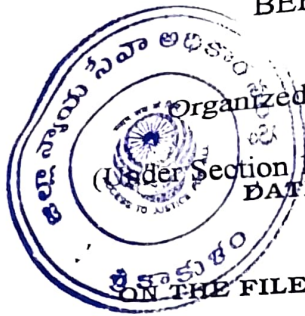

After negotiations and conciliation between the parties, on the advice of the members of the
Lok Adalat and as per the settlement agreed by parties, the following award is passed by the
Lok Adalat.

AWARD

The Petitioner and Respondent No.3/Insurance Company represented by its Authorised person appeared before the Lok Adalat along with their Counsels. The identity of Petitioner is tallied with the photo(s) affixed to the Petition. Both parties submitted that they entered into compromise with the following terms:

The Respondent No.3/Insurance Company has agreed to pay an amount of Rs.2,25,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs and Twenty Five Thousand only) to the Petitioner towards full and final settlement of the Petition claim and the Petitioner has agreed to receive the same.

The Respondent No.3/Insurance Company is directed to deposit the said amount of Rs.2,25,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs and Twenty Five Thousand only) into Court within Three months from the date of the Award, failing which, the petitioner is entitled to receive the agreed amount along with interest @ 12% per annum from the date of Award till the date of realization.

After such deposit, the Petitioner is permitted to withdraw the entire amount of Rs.2,25,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs and Twenty Five Thousand only).

Therefore, compromise is recorded and Award is passed accordingly.

The Claim against 1st and 2nd Respondent is dismissed as not pressed by the petitioner(s).

The Court fee if any paid by the Petitioner(s) shall be refunded as per the Sec.21(1) of the A.P. State Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987.

The parties have been explained the terms of compromise in Telugu and they admitted them to be true.

Both parties have affixed their signatures in evidence of their consent for the terms of the award.
