This is an application under section 483 of B.N.S.S. praying for bail filed by the accused as against the rejection order of the Ld. Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate Islampur in connection with Goalpokher P.S. Case No.167/2026, Dated-17.04.2026,U/S- 329(4)/115(2)/117(2)/118(2)/109(1)/74/304(2)/351(2)/3(5) of BNS, pending before Ld. ACJM, Islampur.

Received the LCR and the CD.

The case record is being taken up for hearing.

Heard Ld. Addl. P. P. and Ld. Counsel for the accused/petitioner.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner submits that no application of a similar nature was/is preferred before the Higher forum nor a similar nature of the application was rejected.

On query, Ld Addl P P submits that there is no reflection in the CD that there is any bail application either pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court and IO also did not intimate him that any bail application is pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court.

Ld Advocate for the accused submitted that the accused is falsely implicated in the case and no such incident had ever taken place as alleged. It is further submitted that the accused is in custody since 26.05.2026 and there is no specific allegation against the present accused petitioner. Hence, he prayed for bail on any condition.

Ld Addl P P raised objection.

Heard. Considered.

Perused the bail petition, the case record and the CD and comparing the same with the statement of witnesses, it appears that the accused petitioner is in custody 26.05.2026 and oral allegations in the statement of witnesses gained support from the medical documents lying in the CD. It further appears that one of the injured was also treated as In-patient and remained admitted for four days.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case and nature of allegation, I am not inclined to enlarge the accused on bail at this stage.

Accordingly, petition u/s 483 of B.N.S.S. stands **rejected**.
