1. Misc. Civil case was called out. I have heard learned counsel for both the parties previously on 12.03.2026. File is fix today for order.
2. I have perused the relevant records and the report of the Presiding Officer of the concerned Court.
3. This transfer application 4C alongwith affidavit 5C has been filed on behalf of the applicant to transfer the O.S. No. 408 of 1996 Smt. Rashmi Versus Smt. Rani Devi & another, pending in the Court of Addl. District Judge, Court no. 14, Prayagraj to the Court of Spl. Judge(S.C./S.T. Act), Prayagraj on the ground of part heard.
4. I have heard the oral submissions advanced by the learned counsel for the applicant. It has been argued suit was heard by the previous P.O. of the Court who got transferred to the Court of Spl. Judge(S.C./S.T. Act), Prayagraj.
5. Learned counsel for the opposite party reiterated the contents mentioned in the objection paper no. 7C and vehemently opposed this transfer application.
6. As per report of the Presiding Officer concerned, the above mentioned case is pending in that Court. The report dated 08.01.2026 obtained from the Presiding Officer of the Court of Spl. Judge(S.C./S.T. Act) reveals that the file was put up again for arguments. It also appears that he is reluctant to hear the matter. Since the case is part heard, there is no occasion or judicial propriety to transfer the case to any other court. No reasonable, cogent and genuine ground has been mentioned in the transfer application. I do not find it proper and sufficient to allow this transfer application. Hence, Transfer application 4C is liable to be rejected.

ORDER

1. The Transfer Application No. 4C is hereby rejected.
2. The copy of the order be sent to the Courts concerned.
3. The Ld. Presiding officer of the concerned court is hereby directed to dispose of the matter expeditiously without making unnecessary adjournments, if possible.
4. This Transfer Application/Misc. Civil Case is disposed of accordingly.
