Learned counsel for the appellant is present.

Heard and perused the file.

The appellant has preferred this appeal under section 70 Food Safety & Standard Act, 2006 against the order dated 22.11.2018 passed by Addl. District Magistrate, (City), Allahabad in Case No. 04700 of 2018 State Vs. Rama Shankar Yadav, under section 51 Food Safety & Standard Act 2006, P.S. Attarsuiya, District Allahabad, whereby the learned Addl. District Magistrate, (City), Allahabad has found the appellant violating the provisions of Section 26(2)(ii) of Food Safety & Standard Act 2006 and thereby imposed punishment of fine of Rs. 01,00,000/- (One lac) on the appellant. it was also directed that the amount of fine imposed shall be deposited through treasury challan within 15 days.

Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that the provisions of Food Safety & Standard Act 2006 have not been followed. The impugned order passed by the Addl. District Magistrate, (City), Allahabad is illegal.

Admit.

Register.

Issue notice to opp. parties.

The appellant has also prayed for staying the operation of the impugned order dated 22.11.2018. The learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that if operation of impugned order is not stayed, purpose of filing of appeal would be frustrated.

Put up on 18.01.2019 for arguments. Summon the lower court record.

Till then operation of the impugned order is stayed.

It is made clear that if adjournment application is moved by the appellant, then the stay order passed shall stand automatically vacated.
