JUDGMENT

(Delivered on 29th day of March, 2022)

Today the accused No.2 is produced before the Court through video conferencing. The accused voluntarily pleads guilty. I therefore, hold accused guilty for the offence punishable under section 3 of the Railway Property (Unlawful Possession) Act, 1966 and proceed to hear him on the point of sentence.

2. The accused submits that he is poor person and the only income source of his family and requests to take lenient view, while imposing sentence upon him.

3. Accused is a poor person, the muddemal property involved in the crime is meager and therefore lenient view needs to be taken while imposing sentence upon the accused. In the circumstances above the following sentence would be sufficient to meet the ends of justice. Hence, order.

ORDER

- (01) The accused No.2. Anand Gangaram Mane is convicted for the offence punishable under section 3 of the Railway Property (Unlawful Possession) Act vide section 246 (3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and he is sentenced to pay fine of ₹ 5,000/- (Five Thousand) in default of payment of fine the accused shall suffer Simple Imprisonment for 01 (One) Month.
- (02) The period of detention, if any undergone by the accused during investigation / inquiry or trial of the case, be set off from the term of imprisonment imposed on him vide section 428 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
- (03) Case to proceed against other accused No.1. Pradipkumar Paramsukh Tiwari and No3. Rohit Shivaji Rathod.
- (04) Copy of judgment be given to accused free of cost.
