IN THE COURT OF SESSIONS JUDGE, AGRA**Transfer Application No. 456 of 2026****Pratham Rajput Vs State****05.06.2026**

This file has been presented for order today and learned counsels for both the parties were heard on the previous date and the file has been perused for order.

This transfer application (3-C) has been moved by the applicant Pratham Rajput u/S. 448 BNSS with the contentions, briefly stated, that the applicant is the accused in S.T. No. 2586/2025 State Vs. Pratham under Case Crime No. 601/2023 which is currently pending in the court of Additional Sessions Judge, Court No. 10, Agra. S.T. No. 2586/2025 State Vs. Pratham was pending in the court of Additional Sessions Judge, Court No. 22, Agra and another S.T. No. 530/2024 State Vs Sandeep Rajput, both relating to the same crime No. i.e. 601/2025 was also pending in the court of Additional Sessions Judge, Court No. 22, Agra. Later on S.T. No. 2586/2025 State Vs. Pratham was transferred to the court of Additional Sessions Judge, Court No. 10, Agra separately from the original file, whereas its original file S.T. No. 530/2024 State Vs. Sandeep Rajput has been transferred to the court of Additional Sessions Judge, Court No. 24, Agra and both the above mentioned sessions trials are pending for evidence. Both the sessions trial pertain to the same crime number. On such grounds it has been prayed to transfer this case. Affidavit 4-C has been filed in support of application 3-C.

In continuation, Court seeked the report in this regard from the concerned courts. The court of Additional Sessions Judge, Court No. 10 has admitted in their report (Paper No. 9-B) that S.T. No. 2586/2025 State Vs. Pratham, Case Crime No. 601/2023 u/s. 306 IPC is pending before the court and listed the next date of hearing as 17.06.2026. As such the court of Additional Sessions Judge, Court No. 24 also submitted its report (Paper No. 10-B) and admitted that S.T. No. 530/2024 State Vs Sandeep Rajput, Case Crime No. 601/2023 u/s. 306 IPC is pending before this court and the next date has been fixed as 17.06.2026 for evidence.

Court heard the learned counsel for the applicant and the learned D.G.C. (Criminal) and found that both the S.T. No. 2586/2025 and 530/2024 are related to same Crime No. 601/2023. So it is necessary that both the cases be heard by one and the same court. So on the above ground Court is of the opinion that the Transfer Application No. 456/2026 of applicant is liable to be allowed.

ORDER

This transfer application is hereby allowed. *Session Trial No. 530/2024 State Vs. Sandeep Rajput* is hereby withdrawn from the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Court No. 24, Agra and made over to the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Court No. 10, Agra for disposal in accordance with law.

Let the concerned Courts be informed accordingly. This Transfer Application Misc. Case is hereby disposed off finally accordingly. Thereafter, this record be duly consigned as per Rules.
