JATINDER KUMAR VS. STATE OF PUNJAB-BA

Application for bail under section 439 Cr.P.C received through Suvidha Center, Jalandhar. It be registered. Notice of the same given to Ld. Addl. PP for State, who was present in the court today. Heard. The counsel for the accused/applicant contended that initially the accused-applicant was released on interim bail vide order dated 17.01.2018, wherein it has been specifically mentioned that the present accused-applicant is admitted on interim bail subject to the result of report of Chemical analysis. It has been further specifically mentioned that it is made clear that this order of interim bail is subject to the report of Chemical analysis. Now the report of Chemical Examiner has been received vide which the contents of alleged recovered intoxicant powder were found to be Alprazolam, Pheniamine and Buprenorphine. Alleged recovery in this case is 2 injections Avil 10 ml each, 2 injections of Puprenorphine 2 ml each and 100 grams intoxicant powder. The alleged recovery of intoxicant powder fall under the ambit of non-commercial. He lastly prayed that the present application may kindly be allowed and bail bonds and surety bonds already furnished be considered in the present bail.

Heard. Keeping in view the above stated facts and circumstances of the present case, the present bail application is allowed and interim bail granted on 17.01.2018 is hereby made absolute on the same terms and conditions. The bail bonds and surety bonds have already furnished by the accused-applicant. As such, there is no need to furnish fresh bail bonds and surety bonds. The instant bail application is accordingly disposed off. Papers be tagged with the main file.
