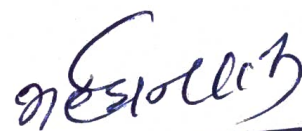
J U D G M E N T

Both accused produced before me at 2.55 p.m. They have no complaint of ill-treatment. They want to plead guilty. They informed of the maximum sentence that can be imposed against them. They still maintained their plea. Satisfied that they are pleading guilty voluntarily.

Heard the accused and Ld. APP. on the point of sentence. Both the accused submitted that they are jobless, poor and are not in a position to pay much fine and prayed for leniency. Considering the nature of offence, the age and antecedents of accused and the fact that there is no record of previous conviction, following punishment in my opinion would be commensurate. Hence the following order.

O R D E R

Both accused are hereby convicted for the offence punishable U/s 27 of N.D.P.S. Act and they are sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment for two days each and to pay a fine of Rs. 2,000/- each (Rupees Two Thousand Only each) in default to undergo simple imprisonment for eight days each.
