Reply perused.

Arguments heard on bail application from both
sides.

1. Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused has argued that
applicant/accused Shabana @ Chanchal had no role in stab
injuries caused to victims and she was falsely implicated in this
case only because she is wife of accused Shahid. It is argued that

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applicant/accused just went to the spot to resolve the matter between her cousin Shabana and her husband Shamshad as they used to quarrel and Shamshad used to frequently batter her after consuming liquor. She did not know that the matter would aggravate at the spot and knives would be used to stab the victims. It is argued that complainant Khurshid and two key-witnesses namely Nafisa Begum and Shamina did not ascribe any active role to applicant/accused Shabana @ Chanchal in stabbing of the victims with knives. It is submitted that the applicant / accused has been in judicial custody since 23/06/2025 and she is innocent.

2. Ld. Addl. PP, on the other hand, strongly opposed the bail application with submission that on 20/05/2025, at around 11:30PM, seven victims were stabbed with knives by accused Shahid, Sajid, Farhan Hashmi and Fejan Hashmi on the small issue of domestic dispute between victim Shamshad and his wife. As per charge-sheet, accused Shahid on being instigated by his wife i.e. applicant/accused Shabana @ Chanchal stabbed victim Shamshad with knife in his abdomen and murdered him. Another accused Sajid caused grievous stab injury on chest of victim Vakil Ali. Knife blows were also inflicted on other victims Akil Ali, Raja and Sakil Ali by accused persons.

Ld. Addl. PP referred to statements of victims as well as independent eye-witness in which active role of applicant / accused Shabana @ Chanchal has been described at the time of

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stabbing of victims by accused persons. Apart from victims, independent eye-witness Neeraj also stated that applicant/accused Shabana @ Chanchal instigated the accused persons to kill the victims. The record prima facie indicates that applicant/accused shared common intention with co-accused persons to inflict knife blows on victims. Three co-accused persons are reported to be still absconding.

3. The case pertains to very grave offence in which one victim was murdered, whereas, another victim sustained grievous stab injury on his chest. Other victims also sustained injuries inflicted by knives. The case is at the stage of arguments on charge and there is sufficient material on record regarding participation of applicant/accused in commission of the offence. The case is not fit for grant of bail to applicant/accused. The bail application is, therefore, dismissed.

The application is disposed of accordingly.
