Heard on the sapurdari application. The report of the concerned police station received, wherein it is submitted that in present FIR No. 77 dated 03.05.2023, U/S 379B, 341, 324, 323, 148, 149, P.S. City-I Abohar, Mobile phone make Samsung A35 having, is lying in the Police Malkhana and same was recovered from the possession of accused during personal search. The police authorities have no objection if the same is given on sapurdari to applicant.

Upon filing of sapurdari application, notice thereof was issued to the Ld. APP for the State. No formal reply has been submitted by the Ld. APP but he has orally opposed the sapurdari application on the ground that the applicant will alienate the mobile and the application be dismissed.

The present application has been filed by applicant/accused Parkash Tirpathi @ Bahaman, who claimed that he is the owner of mobile in question as same was taken into police possession during his personal search. As such, keeping in view the above circumstances and report of the police, the mobile phone in question is ordered to be released to applicant, at the satisfaction of the SHO concerned.
