ORDER:

1. This order of Court shall dispose of the present bail petition filed in case FIR No.09 dated 23.04.2025 u/s 498-A of the IPC registered at Women Police Station, Malerkotla for releasing the present petitioner on anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS.

2. Both the Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the complainant have respectively submitted that a compromise has been effected between the parties and therefore, the present bail petition may

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kindly be allowed.

3. On the other hand, Learned Additional P.P. for the State has not disputed the aforesaid factual position, however, she has opposed the present bail petition.

4. This court has heard Ld. counsel for the petitioner as well as Ld. Additional Public Prosecutor for State and have perused the record of the present case with their able assistance.

5. This Court is of the considered view that as per the allegations levelled against the present petitioner in the present FIR case, it is an admitted fact that the complainant has been married to the petitioner on dated 13.11.2021.

Furthermore, the complainant Mubbassum has made statement in writing in the court that she has arrived at compromise with the petitioner and she is ready to go with her husband with her own free will and consent without any undue influence, threat or pressure. She has further stated that she has no objection if the present bail petition may be allowed on the basis of compromise.

Thus, this court is of the considered view that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required in this case as the complainant and the petitioner Khalil Mohd., the husband of the complainant have arrived at the aforesaid compromise in this matrimonial dispute and both of them have started living together as husband and wife in her matrimonial home. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by

sending the petitioner behind the bars.

6. In view of reasons discussed herein before, the present bail petition filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of BNSS is hereby allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail under Section 482 of BNSS at once, in the event of his arrest on furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of IO/SHO/ Arresting Officer.

7. It is hereby made clear that the present petitioner shall join the investigation as and when required for the same and the concerned SHO/IO is directed to give notice in writing to the present petitioner in case, he is required for any investigation in the present case during the course of investigation

8. File be consigned to the record room.
