CHARGE

I, **Jai Prakash Pandey**, Sessions Judge, Azamgarh, hereby charge all of you **Shailendra Kumar Nigam @ Mantu, Raja @ Shugam, Raju Prasad Nigam, Urmila Devi, Rinki Nigam and Soni @ Saloni Nigam** as follows:

1- That in the night of 24.09.2025, time unkown, at your house situated at Ramleela Maidan, within the limits of P.S. Sidhari, District Azamgarh, regarding the old enmity and acting in furtherance of a common intention, you all have committed murder of complainant's son Sajeb Alam by slitting his neck and thereby you all have committed an offence punishable under **Section 103(1) BNS read with Section 190 BNS** and within the cognizance of this Court.

2- That on the above date, time and place, you all entered into a criminal conspiracy to commit the murder of the complainant's son Sajeb Alam and in pursuance of that conspiracy, acting with a common intention, you all have committed murder of the complainant's son Sajeb Alam by slitting his neck and thereby you all have committed an offence punishable under **Section 61(2) BNS read with Section 103(1) BNS** and within the cognizance of this Court.

3- That in the morning of 25.09.2025, time unknown, at your house situated at Ramleela Maidan, within the limits of P.S. Sidhari, District Azamgarh, you all knowing or having reasons to believe that certain offence, murder of complainant's son Sajeb Alam is punishable with death or imprisonment for life has been committed, did cause certain evidence of the said offence to disappear the dead body of Sajeb Alam by throwing the dead body back side of your house with the intention of screening yourselves from legal punishment, and thereby you all have committed an offence punishable under **Section 238 B.N.S.** and within the cognizance of this court.

4- That on 24.09.2025, at 05.00 PM, at Ramleela Maidan, within the limits of P.S. Sidhari, District Azamgarh, you all, with intent to kill, had kidnapped the complainant's son Sajeb Alam and kept him in your illegal custody and thereafter you all have committed murder of the complainant's son Sajeb Alam by slitting his neck and thereby you all have committed an offence punishable under **Section 140(1) B.N.S.** and within the cognizance of this court.

And I hereby direct that you all be tried by this Court on the said charge.

And I hereby direct that you both be tried by this Court on the said charge.

ORDER

Case called out. Accused persons namely **Shailendra Kumar Nigam @ Mantu, Raja @ Shugam, Raju Prasad Nigam, Urmila Devi, Rinki Nigam and Soni @ Saloni Nigam** are present under judicial custody.

Learned D.G.C. (Crl.) for prosecution opened its case by describing the charge brought against the accused persons and stating by what evidence he proposes to prove the guilt of the accused persons.

Learned counsels for the accused persons has submitted that no prima facie case has been made against accused persons. There is no material against the accused persons.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Upon consideration of the arguments of the learned counsels and perusal of the records, I am of the opinion that prima facie offence under sections 103(1), 61(2), 201, 364, 190B.N.S. & 4/25 A.Act. is made out against the accused persons namely Shailendra Kumar Nigam @ Mantu and Raja @ Shugam and the prima facie offence under Sections 103(1), 61(2), 201, 364, 190B.N.S. is made out against the accused persons namely Raju Prasad Nigam, Urmila Devi, Rinki Nigam and Soni @ Saloni Nigam at this stage and there is sufficient evidence collected by the prosecution to prove its case.

On the basis of the above facts and circumstances, I am of the view that charge for the offence under section 103(1), 61(2), 201, 364, 190B.N.S. & 4/25 A.Act. to be framed against the accused persons namely Shailendra Kumar Nigam @ Mantu and Raja @ Shugam and the charge for the offence under Section 103(1), 61(2), 201, 364, 190B.N.S. to framed against the accused persons namely Raju Prasad Nigam, Urmila Devi, Rinki Nigam and Soni @ Saloni Nigam.

Consequently, you all are being charged for the aforesaid offence. Put up on **02.04.2026** evidence. Summon the witnesses.
