2. On inquiry, Ld. Counsels for applicants/accuseds submit that there is no other bail application of the present applicants/accuseds pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi or Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
3. Pursuant to the directions passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Crl. Appeal No. 825/2026 [Arising out of SLP (Crl.) No. 12669 of 2025] titled as *Zeba Khan vs. State of U.P. & Others*, requisite affidavit has been filed on behalf of applicant/accused.
4. At the threshold, Ld. Counsels for applicants/accuseds submit that they are ready to join and cooperate in the investigation and have requested for interim protection.
5. As per reply filed by the IO, the notice could not be served upon the applicants/accused persons yesterday since they refused to accept the same.

6. One of the applicants/accused persons namely Ms. Rashika Ved is present in person and she accepts the notice and undertakes to join the investigation.

7. Ld. Counsels for applicant(s) have stated that there are cross-case between the parties and that too only on the issue of parking of vehicle.

8. In view of the undertaking, let the applicant/accused join the investigation and cooperate in the same as and when called by the IO.

9. IO is directed to file further detailed reply to the present bail application(s).

10. Put up for filing further detailed reply by the IO on **13.05.2026**.

11. As prayed, interim protection is granted to the applicants/accused persons.

12. As prayed, copy of this order be given dasti to Ld. Counsel for applicant(s).
