ORDER

 Heard on bail application under Section 483 of BNSS filed
by above named applicant/accused in the above noted case FIR.

2. Notice of the bail application was served upon the State and
record of the police station was requisitioned.

3. As per allegations of the prosecution, on 28.01.2025, in the
area of police station Dharamkot, present applicant/accused Neha Kaur
along with her co-accused Angrej Singh were apprehended and from
conscious possession of applicant/accused Neha Kaur 50 gram of Heroin
was recovered and from conscious possession of accused Angrej Singh 30
loose intoxicating tablets were recovered.

4. The alleged recovery of 50 gram of Heroin recovered from present accused/applicant Neha Kaur, falls within the ambit of non-commercial category. The accused/applicant has been in custody since 28.01.2025. The presentation of challan and thereafter, conclusion of trial shall take considerable time. Criminal liability of the applicant/accused, if any, shall be determined on culmination of the trial. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant/accused behind the bars for an indefinite period. Without much commenting upon merits of the case, the bail application is allowed and the applicant/accused is ordered to be released on bail subject to furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to the following terms:-

1. that accused/applicant will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer;
2. that accused/applicant shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court;
3. that the accused/applicant shall appear in the court on each and every date of hearing;

5. A copy of this order be sent to the accused/applicant by e-mail through the Superintendent of the Jail concerned.

6. The requisite bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Papers be tagged with the main challan.
