ORDER

Rahul alias Nikku (applicant/accused), has filed instant second regular bail application after addition of **offence under**

Rachhpal Singh, Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Court, Exclusively to deal with Rape Cases, Ferozepur. UID No. PB0284.

Section 29 of the NDPS Act thereby submitting that, earlier vide Order Dated **14.10.2025** passed by the then learned Judge, Special Court, Ferozepur, in **Bail Application No.3192/2025**, applicant/accused was **granted concession of regular bail qua the offence under Section 21 of NDPS Act** and was ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/-with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ferozepur subject to the conditions as enumerated in the said order. Accordingly, in view of the abovesaid order, applicant/accused furnished bail bonds and surety bonds qua offence under section 21 of NDPS Act but the Jail Authorities failed to release the applicant/accused for the reason that offence under section 29 of NDPS Act, added lateron. Hence prayer made to allow application qua the newly added offence under section 29 of NDPS Act.

2. Notice of the bail application was given to the State and accordingly learned Additional Public Prosecutor has appeared, and submitted that during investigation offence under section 29 of the Act was added subsequently.

3. Police record requisitioned, received and perused.

4. I have heard ***Sh. Ankush Aggarwal, Adv.*** learned counsel for the applicant-accused and ***Sh. Kuldeep Sahni, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State*** and have gone through the police record with their able assistance.

5. Perusal of original file reveals that initially case was registered under section 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act against Rahul alias Nikku and co-accused-non-applicant qua recovery of 48 grams of Heroin, effected from their possession. However, during investigation, offence under section 29 of the Act was added subsequently. Since, applicant/accused has **already been granted concession of regular bail under section 21/61/85 of NDPS Act**, vide ***Order dated 14.10.2025*** passed by the then learned Judge, Special Court, Ferozepur, in Bail Application No.3192/2025, thus he is allowed to be released on bail qua the newly added offence under section ***29 of the Act*** also, ***as per terms and conditions*** enumerated in Bail Order ***dated 14.10.2025***. *This order shall be read as part and parcel of Bail Order dated 14.10.2025, passed in bail application bearing BA 3192-2025 titled as Rahul alias Nikku Versus State.* **The bail bonds already furnished by the**

applicant/accused be also considered qua the newly added offence under section 29 of the Act also and fresh release warrants be issued accordingly.

Application for regular bail stands ***allowed*** accordingly. Copy of this order be sent to the court of Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate for compliance. Papers be consigned to record room, Ferozepur.
