ORDER

This first application for has been moved on behalf of the applicant-accused **Anzum** in crime no. 306/2026 u/ss:103(1) and 61(2) BNS P.S Kotwali City, Distt.Bijnor.

Per prosecution complainant lodged a report that on 21.4.2026 at about 4.30 PM her daughter was alone at home. Rahul came at his home and committed the murder of his daughter Kashish aged about 19 years. At that time she was in Ambala. On receiving information ,she came to lodge the report of this incident with her brother Kapil.

On the basis of this report a case at above stated crime number and section was registered against the accused.

Heard the learned counsel for the accused-applicant as well as learned DGC(Crl.) for State and perused the case diary.

It is submitted on behalf of the accused-applicant that she has been implicated falsely in this case. No body had seen the incident as the complainant was not present at spot. She is not named in FIR. She was not present at spot. Co-accused Rahul is working in a Finance Company and the applicant-accused is the borrower of Finance Company. There is no evidence of section 61(2) BNS against her.

Learned DGC(Crl.) has opposed the bail and submitted that the accused-applicant being colluded with co-accused has committed the murder of a young girl. He has also submitted that the bail of co-accused Rahul has been rejected by the Court of Sessions on 1.6.2026.

In this case,it is alleged that it is the case of direct evidence. It is also alleged that independent witness Mohd. Shahrukh has stated that on the date of alleged incident applicant-accused Anjum got deceased Kashish murdered through the co-accused Rahul. It is also alleged that another independent witness Uzma has also stated that the applicant-accused Anjum who had love affair with co-accused Rahul, did not want that co-accused Rahul maintain any relation with deceased Kashish that's why she got Kashish murdered. It is also alleged that accused-applicant Anjum has stated

in her statement that she did not like the relationship of Kashish and co-accused Rahul and on the date, when the Kashish was murdered, she has disclosed the co-accused Rahul that Kashish was alone at home. It is also alleged that as per C.D.R on 21.4.2026 after committing the murder of deceased, co-accused Rahul talked with accused-applicant Anjum. As per postmortem report, there are five antemortem injuries on the body of deceased in the form of incised wounds and cause of death has been mentioned shock and haemorrhage due to antemortem stab injuries. The offence is heinous in nature as the accused-applicant being colluded with co-accused Rahul got committed murder of a young girl.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case and in view of the gravity of the offence without expressing opinion regarding merit of the case at this stage, it does not appear to be a fit case for bail.

Accordingly, application of accused-applicant is rejected.
