Accused Nand Kishore Khare and Dharambir have already expired.

Vakalatnama of Ld. Counsel for accused Dinesh Kumar Chittoria is already on record the same having been filed along with the application for bail.

Ld. Counsels for accused Dev Singh Bhakuni and Gyan Chand Chopra have filed their respective vakalatnamas. The same are taken on record.

Bailable warrants issued against accused Ajay Vatan have been received back as duly executed and he has appeared before the court today.

Bailable warrants issued against accused Dinesh Kumar Chittoria have been received back as unexecuted on the ground that he had moved an application for cancellation of bailable warrants in the court. The accused has appeared in the court today.

Ld. Counsel for accused Dinesh Kumar Chittoria submits that since the accused has appeared, his application for cancellation of bailable warrants be dismissed as withdrawn. Therefore, **the application is dismissed as withdrawn and the bailable**

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warrants issued on the last date of hearing are not required to be executed.

Ld. Counsels for accused Dev Singh Bhakuni and Gyan Chand Chopra have filed their respective bail applications. The same are taken on record.

Since the other accused persons in the present matter are already on bail and accused Dev Singh Bhakuni and Gyan Chand Chopra have been chargesheeted without arrest, in view of the judgments of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in **Court on its own motion v CBI, (2004) SCC OnLine Del 53** and **Court on its own motion v State, (2018) SCC OnLine Del 12306** (approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Siddharth v State of UP, (2022) 1 SCC 676**), accused Dev Singh Bhakuni and Gyan Chand Chopra are admitted to bail on furnishing of personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- each along with one surety each in the like amount.

Bail bonds on behalf of accused Dev Singh Bhakuni and Gyan Chand Chopra have been furnished. The same be sent for verification through the concerned IO and the report be filed on or before the next date of hearing.

Copies of chargesheet have been supplied to all the accused persons.
