ORDER

Heard the counsel for the applicant Arvind Kumar Seeking release of motorcycle bearing registration no. UP 21 BH 3717 chesis no. MBLHA 10CGHE74213, engine no. HA10ERGHE71570 detained and involved in crime no. 341/2019 u/s:..307,413,414 and 411 IPC P.S Chandpur, Bijnor.

It has been mentioned in release application by the applicant that he is registered owner of above mentioned motorcycle which was seized by the Police. No offence was committed with the vehicle. The vehicle in question has been stationed under open sky. If the vehicle is question is allowed to station at Police station,it will deteriorate. The Sessions trial relating to this crime number has been decided by the Court on 14.8.2025. Therefore,the above stated motorcycle may be released in his favour.

Report has been called from the P.S Concerned.

As per report of Police Station concerned Motorcycle bearing registration no. UP 21 BH 3717 chesis no. MBLHA 10GHE74213, engine no. HA10ER G HE7170 is stationed at Police station Chandpur which is detained in crime no. 341/2019 u/s: 307,413,414 and 411 IPC. Office has reported that the Sessions trial relating to above stated crime number has been decided by this Court on 14.8.2025. He has also annexed the copy of Judgment dt.14.8.2025. As per copy of judgment dated 14.8.2025,the Sessions trial no.

889/2021 Crime no. 341/2019 u/s: 307,413,414 and 411 IPC has been disposed on 14.8.2025 acquitting the accused for the charge levelled against him. D.G.C(Crl.) has reported that at present no appeal is pending against the judgment dated 14.8.2025 of acquittal of accused before the Hon'ble High Court. The photocopy of registration certificate of motorcycle in question has also been perused and tallied the same with the original one, in which the name of registered owner has been mentioned as Mr. Arvind Kumar s/o Sri Ompal Singh. Registration number, chassis number and engine number are the same which has been mentioned in the report of Police Station and in the application of applicant.

Since the Sessions trial relating to above stated crime number has been disposed of by this Court on 14.8.2025. As per report of DGC(Crl.) no appeal has been preferred against this order nor any appeal is pending. Moreover, more than ten months have lapsed of disposal of this Sessions trial. As per copy of registration certificate, the applicant is the registered owner of motorcycle in question hence Motorcycle bearing registration no. UP 21 BH 3717 chasis no. MBLHA 10CGHE74213, engine no. HA 10 E GHE7170 stationed at Police station Chandpur, be released in favour of its registered owner applicant Arvind Kumar s/o Sri Ompal Singh on his filing a PB worth Rs.75000/-.

S.H.O, Chandpur is directed to ensure the release of Motorcycle bearing registration no. UP 21 BH 3717 which is stationed at P.S Chandpur after verifying the papers relating to registered ownership thereof.

Accordingly, Crl. Misc. Case no. 506/2025 is disposed of.
