

State Vs. Prince Saini

Present Shri Sumit Sharma, APP for the State.
Accused Prince Saini on police bail, represented by Shri
Manoj Chauhan, Advocate.

Challan presented today. It be checked and registered. Accused Prince Saini also produced before the court along with challan. An application for regular bail on behalf of accused also moved. Power of attorney on behalf of accused also filed. Notice of the regular bail application be given to state through APP. Reply not filed. Arguments heard. Record perused.

In the instant case, the trial of the case is going to consume considerable period of time despite sincere efforts and challan has been filed today. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the above named accused in custody. Hence, the detention of the accused in custody cannot be authorized. Accordingly, accused is admitted to bail on their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.35,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Requisite bail bonds furnished, accepted and attested. Accused be released on regular bail in this case, if not required in any other case. Necessary endorsement on the documents furnished as security by surety be made or as the case may be, intimation in this regard to concerned authority be sent and Reader is directed to maintain computerized data of all particulars of the sureties as well as details of the properties furnished as security, as is required by the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 1.6.2018 passed in CWP No.4898 of 2018.

Copies of challan supplied to the accused free of costs as envisaged under Section 207 Cr.P.C. His statement also recorded to this effect. Now, the case is adjourned to **09.01.2023** for arguments on charge.
