At this stage, learned counsel for the plaintiff has highlighted the urgency of the matter and pressed for the grant of ad-interim injunction.

On the other hand, learned counsel for defendant has vehemently opposed the same and requested the court for some time to file the reply.

I have heard both the learned counsels for the parties and this court is of the view that in the interest of justice and preventing multiplicity of the suit, **defendants No.1 and 2 are restrained from interfering in the peaceful possession of plaintiff except by following the due course of law.** This order shall be operative till the next date of hearing. However, before parting with this order it is made clear that this order shall have no effect on the merits of the case.

On request of learned counsel for defendants, case stands adjourned to **23.11.2022** for filing written-statement and reply to the stay application on behalf of defendants. Power of attorney on behalf of defendant be also filed on the date fixed.
