O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the plaintiffs.

This Commercial Dispute case has been filed on behalf of the plaintiffs under Section 6 of Commercial Courts Act read with Section 26 of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 for recovery of rs.82,29,240/- along with cost, expenses, pendente lite and future interest @ 18% per annum till realization.

As per the Sheristedar's report, Court fees of Rs.50,000/- is payable.

Learned Counsel for the plaintiff submitted that e-Court fee of Rs.50,000/- has been paid by the plaintiff. Accordingly, prayed to admit the present case.

Perused the record.

From perusal of record, it appears that the claim amount is in between 03 lacs and 01 crore.

The Commercial Courts Act, 2015 has been enacted for speedy disposal of commercial disputes. In exercise of powers conferred by Sec.3 of the Commercial Courts, Commercial Appellate Courts Commercial Divisions and Commercial Appellate Division of High Court Act, 2015 Vide **Notification No.5080 J/ dated 25.07.2019 (English translation Vide Memo No.5250 J/ dated 02.08.2019)** the State Government of Bihar, after consultation with the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Patna **superseding** the previously issued notification Memo no.1150 /J dated 03.03.17 of Law Department, Bihar has been pleased to constitute **Commercial Court and Commercial Appellate Court** in all the districts of the State of Bihar to exercise original jurisdiction in respect of Commercial disputes. The said notification

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dated 02.08.2019 reads as under:

(a) *Constitute the Courts of Civil Judge (Senior Division) of each district as a Commercial Court to exercise original jurisdiction in respect of commercial disputes where the value of the suit or dispute is not less than Rs.3 lacs and up to Rs.1 Crore.*

(b) *Constitute the **Court of District Judge** in all the districts of the State of Bihar as a Commercial Court to exercise original jurisdiction in respect of commercial disputes where the value of the suit or dispute exceeds Rs.1 Crore in respect of the entire territorial area of the district; and*

(c) *Designate the Court of District Judge in each district as Commercial Appellate Court to exercise appellate jurisdiction and to dispose of the appeals arising out of the judgments and orders passed by a Commercial Court below the level of the District Judge.*

So, from the above said notification, it is manifest that Bihar Government has been pleased to constitute the Courts of Civil Judge (Senior Division) where the value of the suit or dispute is not less than Rs.3 lacs and up to Rs.1 Crore. Therefore, Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division) are Commercial Courts which has been constituted by the Bihar Government.

Considering the abovementioned facts and circumstances of the case, this Commercial Dispute case is **admitted**. Issue notice to the opposite parties through registered post after filing requisites by the plaintiffs.

Office is directed to transfer this record to the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division) II, Patna for proceeding in the case as per law.

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Put up this case on 26.05.2025 for further proceedings.
