This Crl. Misc. Case u/s 5 Limitation Act has been filed by the accused to condone the delay in filing Crl. Appeal against the impugned order dated 07.05.2025, passed by the Court of J.M./C.J.(J.D.)/F.T.C./C.A.W., Etah, in Crl. Complaint Case No. 1757/2022 Smt. Rekha Vs. Krishna and ors., whereby the Id. Trial Court has directed the appellant no. 1 to pay Rs.4,000/- per month to the complainant and her daughter towards maintenance.

2. I have heard the Id. Counsel for applicants, Id. Counsel for complainant/respondent and Id. DGC (Crl.) and perused the impugned order dated: 07.05.2025 as well as objections filed by complainant/respondent.

3. From the perusal of the file, it is evident that the impugned order has been passed on 07.05.2025 and thereafter, all the legal formalities, this Crl. Appeal was filed on 26.02.2026. The limitation for filing Crl. Appeal is 30 days from the date of impugned order. In this case, this Appeal has been filed with the delay of approx. 08 months, excluding the time spent in obtaining certified copy of the impugned order. The reasons shown by the applicants for delay in filing this Crl. Appeal, are bonafide and sufficient. In view of this, application u/s 5 Limitation Act of the applicants, deserves to be allowed in the interest of justice.

ORDER

4. Application u/s 5 Limitation Act is hereby allowed. Consequently, the delay in filing Crl. Appeal against the above impugned order, is hereby condoned.
