An application seeking exemption from personal appearance of the complainant has been moved through his counsel.

Heard. In view of the grounds mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Personal appearance of complainant is exempted for today only.

Today the case was fixed for presence of the accused Mahavir proclamation issued against the accused under section 82 Cr.P.C. However none has appeared on his behalf, therefore, accused **Mahavir is declared proclaimed person.**

Details of property of accused Mahavir not filed.

Adjournment sought by the learned counsel for complainant.

Heard. Record perused.

It seems that learned counsel for complainant could not secure any record of property qua accused Mahavir which may be attached under Section 83 Cr.P.C. Hence, further adjournment not warranted. Accordingly no useful purpose would be served by granting the adjournment for this purpose any further. **Hence, file be consigned to record room with a red ink note be given on the file qua not destroying it as the file may be summoned as an**

when accused surrenders or produced before the court by police

It is further made clear that the proceeding under section 83 Cr.P.C. may be revived as and when complainant produces any record qua property of accused Mahavir. At this stage, no further proceedings are required qua accused Mahavir.
