Maninder Singh vs. State of Punjab

ORDER :

1. Heard on the bail application filed by accused – **Maninder Singh** through counsel.

2. It is submitted that prima-facie no case whatsoever is made out against the applicant/accused as the applicant/accused is innocent person and has not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR. The applicant is in judicial custody since 12.07.2026. The applicant has not committed any offence. The alleged occurrence as of dated 14.01.2026 and the police has registered the FIR on 23.05.2026 i.e. after the delay of more than four months and as such the coloured and concocted version cannot be ruled out. Prayer for allowing the bail application has been made.

3. On the other hand, learned APP for the State vehemently argued that the applicant/accused do not deserve the concession of bail as the accused committed serious offences as alleged in the FIR. On these grounds, he has prayed for dismissal of the present application.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the applicant and learned APP for the State and gone through the record.

5. The instant FIR has been got registered against accused/applicant under Section 115(1), 118(1), 126, 304, 324(4), 351(2) BNS for causing injuries to the complainant. In order to grant bail, the seriousness and gravity of the offences is to be taken into consideration. It appears that the allegations against the applicant/accused are of a serious nature. At this stage, no sufficient grounds are made out to grant bail to the applicant. In the light of the facts and circumstances, the custodial interrogation of the applicant is very much necessary.

6. Considering the seriousness of the allegations, this Court is of the considered opinion that the applicant/accused is not entitled to the concession of bail and the present bail application is hereby **dismissed**. Papers be tagged with the remand papers.
