	<u>30.07.2026</u>	The anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely Naresh Paswan, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Jharia P.S. Case No. 158/2022 for the offences u/s 379/411/34 of IPC is pressed for hearing. Copy of the anticipatory bail petition has already been served to the Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State. The Case diary earlier called for has been received. The Prosecution Case in brief is that:- The Informant who is the representative of conductor conductor, and presently posted as representative conductor of Food State Corporation, Dhanbad who written an application to the o/c of Jharia P.S. hence this case registered as Jharia P.S.Case no.158/2022 on 25/07/2022 registered U/sec. 379/411/34 of I.P.C. against this accused person accused vehicle no.WB42D 0910 driver and owner and other parsons JSFC rice was unloading from the truck stealing and caught raid-hand which was registered FIR. It is mentioned FIR NO.03/22 seized 04 bags weight about 02 quintal rice was kept safely in the P.3. premises. To the O/C of Jharla P.S, distt. Dhanbad subjects. In connection with taking messary action, with due respect beg to state that Ashiwad Kumar, aged 30 years, son of Nirmal Kumar, R/o, Sasarom Hari nagar, P.S. Muffassi, distt. Rohtas (Bihar) present residence of Dhanbad Rani talab, Gokul Apartment 105 D. P.S. Dhanbad, where he is resident and presently conductor outhorised representative of Jharkhand State Food Corporation, Dhanbad on 11.7.2022	

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	<u>Contd...</u> <u>30.07.2026</u>	The Ld. counsel for the applicant further submits that the petitioner is fully innocent person and has not committed any such of fence which has been mentioned In FIR. The rice bags which was recovered from the Alto car which is not of the petitioner presently as because the petitioner purchased the said Alto Car from previous owner Pankaj Thakur and after ore month, the petitioner returned the said car to Pankaj Thakur because the R.C. in respect of the said cat was not being transferred in my name by the Pankaj Thakur. The petitioner was not caught on the spot rather there was no recovery from the possession of this petitioner. The petitioner returned back to his Alto Car to the Previous owner namely Pankaj Thakur and at the time of returning the said Alto car, the two witnesses were present. The said vehicle Alto car is of the West Bengal bearing its registration numbers WB42D-0910, whose owner is of the West Bengal who is a lady registered owner of the said Alto car. The petitioner has replied to the notice of U/sec. 35(3) of B.N.SS already. The petitioner has falsely men implicated in this case. The petitioner is a Masion (Rajmistri) and who is the only bread-earner of his family and maintain her family alone. At the time of returning back the said vehicle Alto Car by the petitioner to Pankaj Thakur and at that time, an agreement was executed between the petitioner and Pankaj Thakur which was tax torn before the petitioner & Pankaj Thakur and Pankaj Thakur told/assured to the petitioner that the said car now becomes to him and there is no med of any documents. Hence, the petitioner is not a registered owner of the said Alto Car. The petitioner is a local man. The petitioner undertakes and also ready to abide by the conditions as laid down u/sec.439 Cr.P.C. and Usec.482 of B.N.S.S., 2023 and

On these enumerated grounds, the learned counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the accused petitioner. The learned Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail. On the perusal of the case diary especially para no.2 informant in his re-statement has supported the version of the prosecution and also witnesses namely Rahul Prasad Singh, Bhuneshwar Oraon, Md. Nasim has also supported the case of the prosecution which is clear from the para no.-9,10,11 of the case diary. The Maruti Car bearing no.WB42D-0910 which has been caught on the spot and in which four bori of rice was loaded. The above said car is still in the name of Sushmita Gour and from para no.89 of the case diary that she has already sold it to B.K. Auto Pvt. Ltd. by exchanging it with maruti true value and further it transpires that it has been sold to one Shankar Nath and from Shankar Nath it was sold to two persons namely Rohit Kumar Chouhan and Pankaj Kumar and further Pankaj Chouhan sold it to the applicant which is clear from para no.106 of case diary and sale agreement is also annexed in the case diary. The applicant could not show any document that the vehicle was again re-sold to the Rohit Kumar Chouhan and Pankaj. The allegation against that he is among the other three to four persons who ran away form the place of the incident. Notices has been served to the wife and daughter of the applicant but he has not joined the investigation. There is agreement between the Pankaj Kumar and present applicant of the year 14.08.2020 which shows that the car which is being used for stealing belongs to the present applicant.
