This bail application has been filed by the accused/applicant Abhishek Kumar Dube, involved in Case Crime No. 54/2026, under Sections 85, 80(2) BNS & 3/4 D.P. Act, P.S. Gaurabadshahpur, District Jaunpur.

The prosecution story in brief is that the complainant Amit Shukla lodged an FIR at P.S. Gaurabadshahpur, Jaunpur alleging therein that the marriage of his sister Moni was solemnized (love marriage) with Abhishek Dube 02 years ago. After marriage, husband Abhishek, mother-in-law, brothers-in-law Raju and sister-in-law Vandana of his sister used to torture and harass her for the demand of dowry. 3-4 days ago, Moni called her mother and told about the whole incident. On 26.11.2024, at about 09.00 AM. Morning, police officials informed him that his sister died. When he went her sasural, her dead body was there. Her in-laws told that due to dome dispute between husband and wife, both are consumed *Salphas* on 24.11.2024, at about 09:00 o'clock. Soni died in Sadar Hospital. They brought her dead body without conducting post-mortem and Abhishek is admitted in Varanasi in a critical situation. His brother Vijay Shukla give an application in Gaurabadshahpur about the incident and then the Panchayatnama and post-mortem were started.

Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned DGC (Crl.) for the state and perused the materials available on record.

Learned counsel for the applicant has contended that the applicant is innocent and he has not committed any offence. The accused/applicant has no connection with the deceased. The accused/applicant is husband of the deceased. He had never demanded any dowry from the deceased or her parents. The prosecution case is totally false and fabricated. The accused/applicant has no criminal history. The accused/applicant is languishing in jail since 26.04.2026. On the above grounds, it is prayed that the applicant be released on bail.

Learned DGC (Crl.) has opposed the bail application and argued that accused/applicant along with other co-accused demanded dowry, subjected cruelty and caused dowry death.

Heard and perused the materials available on record.

The deceased was found dead in unnatural circumstances within 7 years of her marriage in her matrimonial home. There is serious allegations regarding demand of dowry. It is also alleged that she was subjected to cruelty for demand of alleged dowry. Accused/applicant is husband of the deceased and he is named in FIR. From the perusal of case diary it is evident that complainant and other witnesses has supported the prosecution version in their statement u/s 180 BNSS. As per post mortem report of the deceased, cause of death could not be ascertained hence Viscera preserved for forensic analysis. In report of viscera, Aluminum phosphide poison is found. Being husband of the deceased, the accused/applicant is primarily responsible for the incident. The investigation is still going on. The allegation against the accused/applicant is serious in nature.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and gravity of offence, the bail application is liable to be rejected.

Order

Application for bail of accused/applicant Abhishek Kumar Dube, involved in Case Crime No. 54/2026, under Sections 85, 80(2) BNS & 3/4 D.P. Act, P.S. Gaurabadshahpur, District Jaunpur is rejected.
