This bail application has been filed by the accused/applicant Manoj Saroj, involved in case Crime No. 442/2025, under Sections 69, 351(2), 137(2) B.N.S., P.S. Badlapur, District- Jaunpur.

The prosecution story in brief is that complainant Gaytri Devi lodged an FIR at P.S. Badlapur, Jaunpur alleging therein that his co-villager Manoj Saroj is very stubborn and cunning person. On 12.10.2025, at about 03.00 AM morning, he enticed away his daughter. She searched her, but not found her.

Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned D.G.C. (Crl.) for the state and perused the materials available on record.

Learned counsel for the applicant has contended that the applicant is innocent and he has not committed any offence. The accused is named in FIR. The prosecution version is totally false and fabricated. There is no evidence of the alleged incident. The accused/applicant is in jail since 25.03.2026. The FIR version is totally false and fabricated. On the above grounds, it is prayed that the accused/applicant be released on bail.

Learned D.G.C. (Crl.) has opposed the bail application and alleged that accused/applicant enticed away the daughter of the complainant.

The FIR has been lodged by mother of the victim. Accused/applicant is named in the FIR. FIR has been lodged under Section 137(2), 351(2) BNS, during investigation Section 69 BNS has been added. The complainant has supported the prosecution version in her statement recorded under Section 180 and 183 BNSS and also stated that they new each other and also used to talk for 02 years. She went with him and stayed in Pune. She has got pregnant due to the physical relation having made by the accused/applicant. The possibility of prosecutrix being consenting party cannot ruled out. The investigation is still going on. No other criminal history has been produced by the prosecution. The accused is languishing in jail since 23.05.2026.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, bail application deserves to be allowed.

Order

Application for bail of the accused/applicant Manoj Saroj, involved in case Crime No. 442/2025, under Sections 69, 351(2), 137(2) B.N.S., P.S. Badlapur, District- Jaunpur is allowed. Applicant be released on bail on furnishing a personal bond of Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty thousand) and two reliable sureties each in the like amount subject to satisfaction of the magistrate concerned.
