This bail application has been filed by the accused/applicant Akash @ Gulshan Yadav involved in case Crime No. 27/2026 under Section 123, 303(2) BNS, P.S. Nevadhiya, District Jaunpur.

The prosecution story in brief is that complainant Shobhnath lodged an FIR in P.S. Nevadhiya, Jaunpur alleging therein that on 25.02.2026 at about 10:00 O'clock, he was waiting the bus for Mirjapur. Two person came on Maruti Car and offered him to Mirjapur with him. On the way, they given him juice in which they had mixed something. After sometime, he slept and they looted his Rs. 8,000/- and ornaments and thrown him along the road. On information, his son took him to the hospital.

Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned DGC criminal for the state and perused the materials available on record.

Learned counsel for the applicant has contended that the applicant is innocent and he is falsely implicated. He has no connection with the alleged incident. There is no recovery from his possession. There is no solid evidence against him. The FIR version is totally false

and fabricated. On the above grounds, it is prayed that the accused be released on bail.

Learned DGC (Criminal) has opposed the bail application and stated that direct allegation of abatement to commit suicide has been levelled against the present accused.

Allegation of causing hurt by means of poison and committing theft have been levelled against accused/applicant. He is not named in the FIR, his name came into light during investigation. No stolen article is said to be recovered from the possession of accused/applicant. Accused/applicant is languishing in jail since 19.05.2026. 17 other criminal history of the accused/applicant have been produced by the prosecution, but only criminal history cannot be the sole ground for rejection of bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, submissions made in bail application, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, bail application deserves to be allowed.

Order

Application for bail of accused/applicant Akash @ Gulshan Yadav in Crime No. 27/2026, P.S. Nevadhiya, Jaunpur is allowed. Applicant be released on bail on furnishing a personal bond of Rs. 1,00,000/- (One lakh) and two reliable sureties each in the like amount subject to satisfaction of the court concerned.
