This Bail Application has been filed by the accused/applicant Atul Kumar Kannaujiya under Sections 109, 115(2), 352, 61(2) B.N.S., in Crime No. 191/2026, P.S. Line Bazar, Jaunpur.

The prosecution story in brief is that complainant Ambe Prasad Yadav lodged an FIR at P.S. Line Bazar, Jaunpur alleging therein on 14.05.2026, at about 08.30 o'clock, the complainant was going to civil Court, when he reached near *Pili Kothi (T.D. Law Collage)*, some unknown persons stopped him showing pistol and started abusing him. They assaulted on the head of complainant using iron rod due to which the complainant became unconscious and caused serious injuries to them.

Learned counsel for the applicant has contended that the applicant is innocent and he has not committed any offence. The accused/applicant has no criminal history. There is a conspiracy. The prosecution story is totally false and fabricated. There is no independent eye witness of the alleged incident. The accused/applicant is in judicial custody since 23.05.2026. There is no recovery from his possession. On the above grounds, it is prayed that the accused/applicants be released on bail.

Learned DGC (Criminal) has opposed the bail application and stated that accused/applicant along with other co-accused assaulted the complainant and caused serious injuries to him.

Heard and perused the materials available on record.

Allegations of assaulting, causing serious injuries and abusing have been levelled against the accused/applicant and other co-accused persons. The accused is not named in FIR, but his name came into light during investigation. Injured Ambe Prasad has sustained 03 injuries in the occurrence. X-Ray report and supplementary reports are not available on record. The said injuries are allegedly caused by hard and blunt object. 03 unknown persons are named in FIR, but no specific role of the accused/applicant has been assigned in FIR. The investigation is still going on. No other criminal history of the accused/applicant has been produced by the prosecution. The accused/applicant is languishing in jail since 23.05.2026.

Considering the facts and circumstances of case, submissions made in bail application and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the bail application deserves to be allowed.

Order

Application for bail of accused/applicant Atul Kumar Kannaujiya under Sections 109, 115(2), 352, 61(2) B.N.S., in Crime No. 191/2026, P.S. Line Bazar, Jaunpur is allowed. Applicant be released on bail on furnishing a personal bond of Rs. 1,00,000/- (One Lakh) and two reliable sureties each in the like amount subject to satisfaction of the court concerned.
