This anticipatory bail application has been filed by the accused/applicants Mahaveer Yadav, Jaisingh Yadav and Ramsingh Yadav involved in Case Crime No. 252/2026, under Section 108 BNS, P.S. Buxa, District Jaunpur.

The prosecution story in brief is that complainant Jayshankar Yadav lodged an FIR at P.S. Buxa, Jaunpur alleging therein that there is a land dispute between him his co-villagers Mahaveer Yadav, Arjun Yadav, Jaysingh Yadav and Ramsingh Yadav. They forcibly try to make Chakmarg and C.C. road on his land. His family family members opposed them. Due to which his brother Prakash Yadav climbed on the tower to oppose them, but the O.Ps. instigated him to jump from the tower and his brother died due to the fall.

Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned DGC (Crl.) for the state and perused the materials available on record.

Learned counsel for the applicants has contended that the applicants are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this

case. FIR version is totally false and fabricated. They have never tortured the deceased. The accused/applicants are in judicial custody. The accused/applicants have no criminal history. The prosecution story is totally false. They have anticipation to be arrested by the police concerned and it is prayed that the accused/applicant be released on anticipatory bail.

Learned DGC (Crl.) has opposed the bail application and alleged that accused/applicant subjected cruelty and instigated to jump from the tower.

As per prosecution story, allegation of instigating the deceased to commit suicide has been levelled against the accused/applicants and other co-accused persons. It is admitted in the above prosecution case that there was a property dispute between the family of the deceased and the accused persons. It is also alleged that accused/persons was constructing Chak Marg and Concrete Cement Road in the land of the deceased and to protest that deceased had climbed on a Tower and jumped there from. It is pertinent to mention that Chak Marg and Concrete Cement Road cannot be made by a private person and the same would have been constructed by Revenue Officials. It seems that due to the property dispute the accused/applicant has been implicated in the present case. The investigation is still going on. Co-accused Arjun has been enlarged on regular bail by this court.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, submissions made in bail application, accused/applicants deserves to be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, this anticipatory bail of accused/applicants Mahaveer Yadav, Jaisingh Yadav and Ramsingh Yadav in Crime 252/2026, P.S. Buxa, Jaunpur is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the applicants, he shall be released on anticipatory bail on his furnishing a personal bond of Rs. 1,00,000/- (One Lakh) with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of court concerned with the following conditions:-

1. Applicants shall make themselves before court on each and every fixed and and co-operate in trial.
2. Applicants shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement or threat to any person acquainted.
3. Applicants shall not leave the district without previous permission of the court.

On breach of any of the condition imposed on, the anticipatory bail shall automatically deemed to be rejected.
