This petition coming on 19.10.2022 for final hearing; upon hearing the
counsel on record and considering the material on record and having stood
over for consideration till this day, this Court has made the following:

ORDER

The petitioner, who is alleged to have committed offences punishable
under Sections 406, 409, 417 and 420 IPC and Section 5 of the Depositors Act,
seeks bail on the ground that he could not appear before the Court earlier as
he was suffering from severe ailments and undertakes to appear before the

Court regularly till the disposal of the case.

2. The Public Prosecutor opposed the petition stating that the petitioner was proclaimed offender, that the petitioner is also involved in other similar cases and that if the petitioner is granted bail, he may repeat the offences.

3. The crime is of the year 2009. Charge-sheet filed on 28.10.2014 was registered as CC No.2 of 2018. As the petitioner was absconding, the case against him was split up from the said CC No.2 of 2018 and was numbered as CC No.2 of 2019. NBW issued was returned. The petitioner's sureties paid the penalty imposed against them. Despite publication of proclamation under Section 82 CrPC, the petitioner did not appear before the Court. After enquiry under Section 299 CrPC, the said case was transferred to Register of Long Pending Cases and was assigned LPC No.2 of 2022. On 9.10.2022 the petitioner was produced before the Court and was remanded to judicial custody. On 10.10.2022 the case against the petitioner was registered as CC No.1 of 2022 and since then the petitioner has been in remand.

4. The record shows that the petitioner avoided trial by jumping the bail. In view of this and in view of the other submissions made on behalf of the prosecution, it is just and proper not to consider the request of the petitioner.

5. In the result, the petition is dismissed.
