The present Sessions Trial is connected with Case Crime No. 907 of 2017 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 307, 308, 323, 326, 452, 504, 506 IPC., PS Gursahayganj, District Kannauj. The informant of the above said case and accused persons have entered into a compromise and accused persons of the above case namely Ayyaj, Dabir, Kadir, Rashid, Sajid, Layeek, Ahtishamuddin alias Lalla, Mustaq, Khalid, Kasim, Pervej and Usimraza alias Guddu filed an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. bearing No. 32946 of 2024 and the Hon'ble High Court by its order dated 15.04.2025 passed orders in the above Session Trial Case.

The certified copy of order dated 15.04.2025 was filed before this court and this court took note of the fact that Sections 452, 326, 506 of the IPC were not mentioned in the order passed by Hon'ble High Court. When this court by its order dated 15.05.2025 pointed out that fact, the accused persons of the above Sessions Trial filed an application under Section 528 of the BNSS bearing No. 34767 of 2025. The Hon'ble Court by its order dated 19.01.2026 has taken note of the fact that earlier an order was passed on 15.04.2025 in which Sections 452, 326 and 506 of the IPC were not mentioned and finally passed the following order:-

- 5. It is not in dispute that both the parties have amicably settled the matter and proceedings of Session Trial No. 1356 of 2023 were quashed by this Court vide order dated 15.04.2025. As the proceedings had already been quashed by this Court vide order dated 15.04.2025, so there is no useful purpose to continue the said proceedings on the mere ground that Sections 452, 326 and 506 I.P.C. are not mentioned in the order.*
- 6. It is clarified that in view of the order dated 15.04.2025 by this Court, the proceedings of Session Trial No. 1356 of 2023 pending in the court of District and Session Judge, Kannauj be also treated to have been quashed for the offence punishable under Sections 452, 326 and 506 I.P.C.*

As the Hon'ble High Court by its order dated 19.01.2026 has modified its order dated 15.04.2025 and a direction has been issued that the order dated 15.04.2025 shall be read including the offences committed under Section 452, 326 and 506 of the IPC along with the Sections mentioned in the order dated 15.04.2025 passed in application bearing No. 32946 of 2024 have been quashed.

As Hon'ble High court has quashed the entire criminal proceeding arising out of Case Crime No. 907 of 2017 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 307, 308, 323, 326, 452, 504, 506 IPC. P.S. Gursahayganj, nothing remains to be done in this Sessions Trail. Consequently, the case is closed and the file is consigned to the record room as per rules.
